CODE OF CONDUCT AND DRESS CODE

- Students are expected to be respectful, courteous and kind towards teachers, staff, visitors and classmates.

- Students should wear comfortable clothing to rehearsals, classes or workshops something that they can easily move in, and don't mind getting a little dirty.
- Students are expected to enter class on time. Please allow for Charleston traffic.
